SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

This was another busy shift. During the shift, a total of 7 larceny reports were taken. These were mostly by the officers who were involved in the retail theft operation which resulted in several theft related arrests being made. Early in the shift, officers responded to an injury accident in front of EMC Emergency Room. The collision caused a vehicle to strike a power pole, which caused the power to be down for about 4 hrs. EMC was not affected, but the retirement complex across the street was. TID worked quickly to get that corrected. Once the power pole was supported, the vehicles were towed from the scene, and no major injuries were reported. Officers also investigated a possible juvenile molestation being

perpetrated by an unknown male who is a friend of the victims relative. This investigation is in its early stages.
