SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Officers responded to a larceny from different vehicles this morning that had just occurred. The reporting party gave suspect description of three male juveniles who were seen entering unlocked vehicles and rummaging through them. Officers located all three males and determined they were involved in the thefts. They were arrested and released to their parents. Officers also made a traffic stop and determined the driver had a warrant. When officers tried to make the arrest, the male suspect began to resist. After a short struggle the male was taken into custody. Towards the end of shift an officer saw a vehicle he recognized as stolen. A traffic stop was made and the driver yielded. He was taken into custody for possession of a stolen vehicle.

We had another busy shift with calls for service and self-initiated activity. Officers were in the area of W. Main St and N. Tully Rd when a vehicle stop was conducted due to several moving violations. The driver and passenger were contacted and they both displayed indicators of being under the influence of alcohol. During sobriety test of the driver, the

passenger kept intervening in the investigation. The passenger then got into the driver's seat and refused to get out of the vehicle. The passenger resisted arrested and assaulted an officer before being taken into custody. The driver was ultimately arrested for DUI. Both were booked into jail.
