MONTHLY SPECIAL DEPLOYMENT EFFORTS:

- 1. On Saturday, May 4, 2019, the Turlock Police Department housed the annual Police Department Open House. Congressman Josh Harder spoke during the opening ceremonies and joined the Chief in welcoming everyone, followed by Turlock Police Officer Gavin Allison singing the National Anthem. Citizens were able to take facility tours, view a K9 and Traffic Unit demonstration, children were able to ride their bikes through the Bike Rodeo, and enjoy donuts and coffee. Approx. 3,500 community members attended.
- 2. S.I.U. Detectives, along with Stanislaus County S.I.U., conducted a Human Trafficking Operation that resulted in five (5) arrests. Four (4) of the arrests were for prostitution and one (1) arrest was for pimping.
- 3. V.I.P.S. attended the Regional Volunteer Academy, which is a ten (10) week course.
