SPECIAL DEPLOYMENT EFFORTS:

- Detectives, Probation, TNET, and CORE collaborated on a Probation sweep for community mailbox break-in suspects. An arrest was made that lead to the recovery of ## pieces of potential mail/identity theft.
- The Crime Analyst created and dispersed multiple work-ups on the dentist burglary series that had been occurring since May 2016. The Analyst was in close communication with allied agencies, each sharing information about the suspects as they became available. On February 18, 2017, Modesto Police Department made two arrests, and Turlock Detectives responded to interview the suspects. After questioning, the primary suspect confessed to a Turlock Detective to 40+ break-ins.
- The SWAT team borrowed Ceres Police Department's Bearcat (multipurpose armored rescue and personnel delivery vehicle) to assist the FBI in a drug and weapons related high risk search warrant that lead to multiple arrests and the recovery of drugs and weapons.

PROACTIVE PATROL EFFORTS:

- CORE officers:
 - Conducted community outreach to dental offices as a response to a series of Dental/Medical office burglaries. CORE officers and VIPS made personal visits to 35+ offices to discuss CPTED (Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design) tips, and how offices could prevent becoming a possible victim to a break in.
 - Conducted community outreach to neighbors surrounding a problem house that has been reported for multiple types of crime. Positive working relationships were formed that will help to address future issues in the area if they arise again.
 - Visited students in After School Programs and were able to interact with kids playing basketball and several other games, including helping with homework.
- Animal Services conducted proactive animal license checks at 194 individual homes during the month of February.
