- 1. AMENDMENT TO CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 2008-03 (TURLOCK POKER ROOM)
  To amend Condition of Approval #1 for an existing card game business in an existing shopping center to change the maximum number of card tables allowed at the site from 10 to 14 card tables in operation at any one time, if permitted by local ordinance. The project site is located at 2321 West Main Street (Stanislaus County Assessor's Parcel Number 089-014-041). The project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with CEQA § 15183 (c)(1)(B) (Projects Consistent with a Community Plan, General Plan, or Zoning) and/or Section 15301 [Existing Facilities].

There is a \$125.00 filing fee for the Appeal Application. If an Appeal Application is filed, a Public Hearing will be scheduled by the City Council to consider the appeal.

The request must be written and filed with the City of Turlock Planning Division. There is a \$305.00 Filing Fee Deposit for the Continuance Request Application. The granting of a request for a continuance of a pending application is discretionary on the part of the City of Turlock.
