1. GENERAL PLAN CONFORMITY FOR PUBLIC REALIGNMENT OF THE EXISTING DIANNE DRIVE TO AUTO MALL DRIVE: The City is proposing to abandon a portion of the existing Dianne Drive from north of Poulus Drive to Fulkerth Road and realign Dianne Drive to Auto Mall Drive. The realignment is required to accommodate the future expansion of the Highway 99/Fulkerth interchange and the construction of a new signalized intersection at Fulkerth Road and Dianne Drive. Dianne Drive will be constructed as a 76 foot wide Industrial street with a bike lane in accordance with the Turlock General Plan. Properties affected by the abandonment and acquisition of rightof-way include APN's 089-019-005, -006, -017, -018, -020, and -024. The Planning Commission will consider making a finding of conformance with the Turlock General Plan.

I. COMMISSIONER'S CONSIDERATION

WORKSHOP ON POTENTIAL AMENDMENTS TO THE TURLOCK SIGN

REGULATIONS: The Planning Commission will continue its discussion on Turlock's Sign Regulations with specific emphasis on temporary signs and sign spinners. Staff will also be presenting a potential approach to revise the current regulations using the sign regulations for the City of Rancho Cucamonga as a model. Staff will present options for discussion only by the Planning Commission. No action will be taken by the Planning Commission. Once specific amendments are formulated, staff will circulate the proposed amendments for public review in accordance with City regulations and the California Environmental Quality Act. The proposed amendments will then be presented at a future public hearing of the Planning Commission.

WORKSHOP ON POTENTIAL AMENDMENTS TO THE TURLOCK ZONING

REGULATIONS: The workshop will cover several key areas of the Zoning Regulations that the City is considering amending in response to public requests or to bring the regulations into compliance with the recently adopted General Plan. Staff will provide an overview of the topics that will be covered in the comprehensive zoning ordinance amendment. More detailed presentation will be made on the topics of electrified fences, accessory structures, drive through facilities, and the Downtown Turlock zoning overlay regulations. Staff will present options for discussion only by the Planning Commission. No action will be taken by the Planning Commission. Once specific amendments are formulated, staff will circulate the proposed amendments for public review in accordance with City regulations and the California Environmental Quality Act. The proposed amendments will then be presented at future public hearing of the Planning Commission.

Anyone who is dissatisfied with the action(s) of the Planning Commission may file an appeal within <u>TEN (10)</u> <u>DAYS</u> following the decision of the Planning Commission. The appeal must be written and filed with the Turlock City Clerk. Appeal Application Forms are available in both the City Clerk and Planning Division Offices, 156 South Broadway, Turlock. There is a \$125.00 filing fee for the Appeal Application. If an Appeal Application is filed, a Public Hearing will be scheduled by the City Council to consider the appeal.

--CONTINUANCE---- APPLICANT REQUESTS--EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 27, 1989

An applicant may request the continuance of a pending application or scheduled matter set for consideration by the Planning Commission by filing a request for a continuance not less than three (3) hours prior to the scheduled consideration of the application pursuant to City Council Resolution No. 89-248. The request must be written and filed with the City of Turlock Planning Division. Continuance Request Application Forms are available in both the City Clerk and Planning Division Offices, 156 South Broadway, Turlock. There is a \$305.00 Filing Fee Deposit for the Continuance Request Application. The granting of a request for a continuance of a pending application is discretionary on the part of the City of Turlock. The applicant's compliance with the regulations does not imply, guarantee, or otherwise supersede the City of Turlock's authority to deny the request.
