#### **NONCONSENT ITEMS**

These items will be individually discussed and reviewed in detail.

1. AMENDMENT TO CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 2004-07 (REFERRED TO AS CUP 2015-04) – CALVARY CHAPEL OF TURLOCK – An amendment to an approved Conditional Use Permit to allow an approximately 9,500 square foot tenant space and 4,700 square foot outdoor venue, currently occupied by the Two Guys Catering and Red Brick café and addressed as 153 S. Broadway, (Stanislaus County APN: 061-016-046) to provide for an additional use to be used at a future date as a church and worship center with an outdoor venue. The church is currently permitted to operate within the portion of the building addressed as 147 S. Broadway. The permit will not extinguish or modify the current Condition Use Permit 2004-07, as amended, that allows Two Guys Catering and Red Brick Café to operate but will add the

proposed use as a potential future use within the same space used by the Two Guys Catering and Red Brick Café. The project is Exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15301 (e) (Existing Facilities). <u>View</u> <u>Item</u>

- 2. GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT 2015-02 ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PLAN: The City of Turlock is proposing to adopt an Active Transportation Plan ("Plan") to implement Policy 5.3-k of the Turlock General Plan which calls for the preparation of a Bicycle Master Plan. The Plan identifies the existing and future bicycle and pedestrian transportation network, as well as the specific projects necessary to carry out the plan, and +also includes a range of programs to encourage and support biking and walking within the City of Turlock. This project is EXEMPT from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15162 (Projects consistent with a previous EIR); Section 15183 (Projects consistent with the General Plan); and/or Section 15162 (Feasibility and planning studies).
